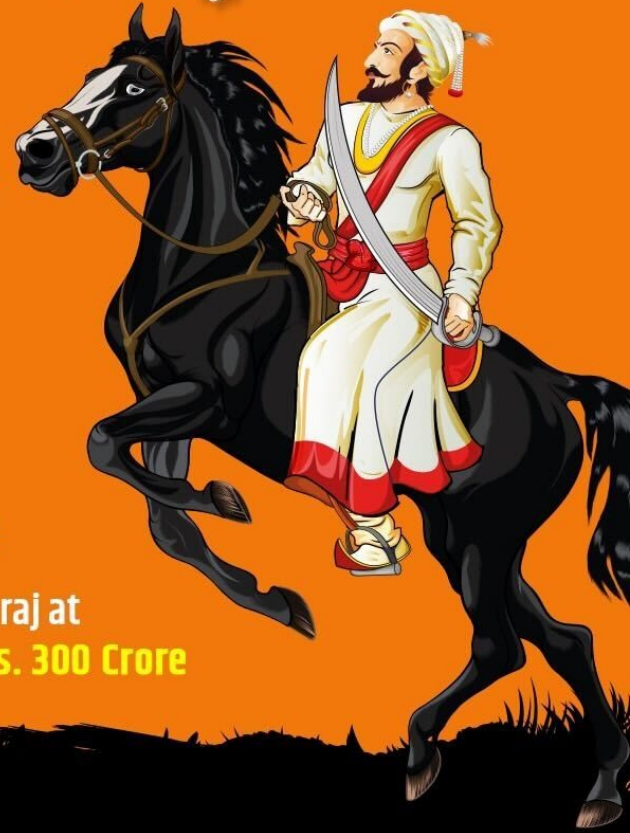

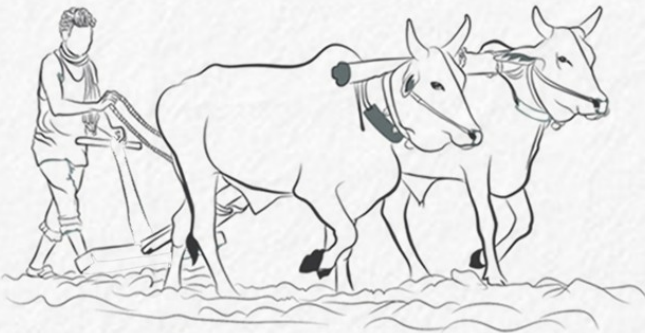

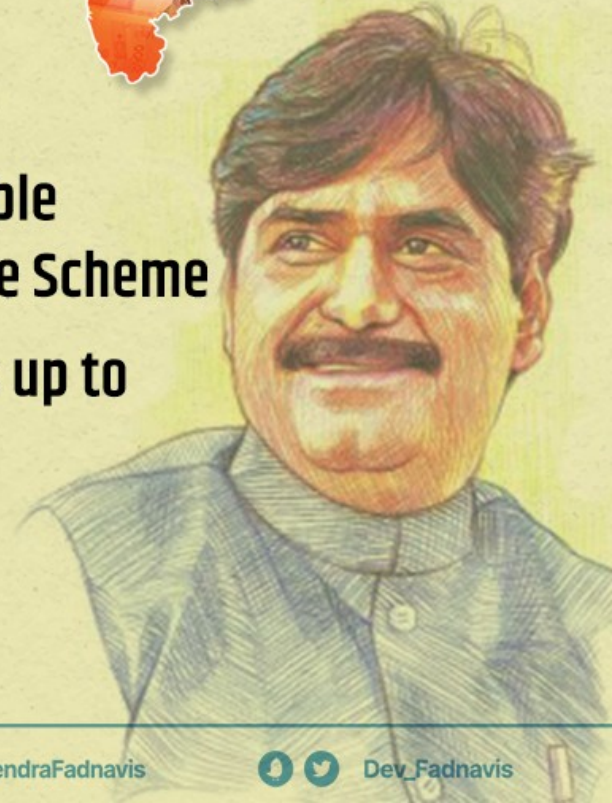

WELFARE OF THE FISHERMEN FAMILIES

Fisheries Development Fund of 50 crore, insurance and diesel subsidy

- Maharashtra is the first state to implement compensation policy for the project-affected fishermen.
- 2 percent of the project cost or Rs. 50 crore Fisheries Development Fund for the displaced or the temporarily affected fishermen families.
- Condition of 120 HP limit for the mechanical boats for the diesel subsidy is taken off.
- It will benefit to more than 85 thousand fishermen.

- The fishermen engaged in traditional fishing will be provided with insurance of Rs. 5 lakh with the help of Union Government.

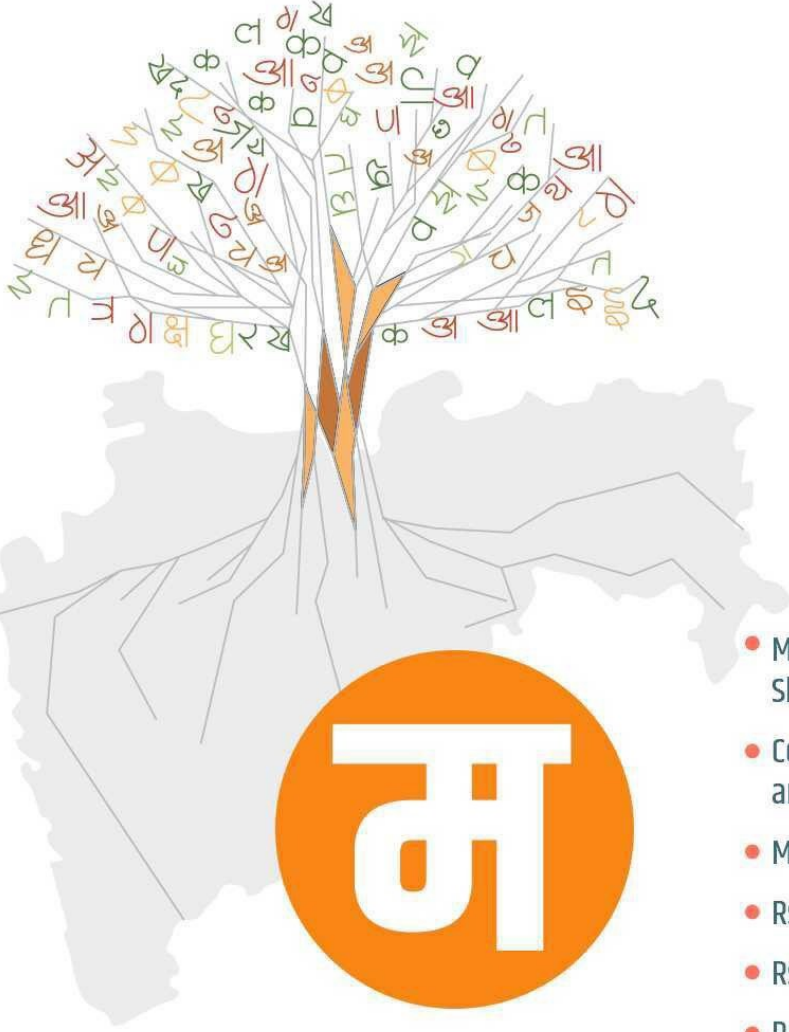
- The **GST Amnesty scheme 2023** has been introduced
- This Amnesty scheme will be applicable from 1 May 2023 to 31 October 2023
- Tax payers can file pending returns on or before 1 May 2023
- Complete waiver of arrears in cases where arrears are **2 Lakh** or less per year, this will benefit **1 Lakh** small traders
- For dues up to **Rs. 50 lakh** if the tax payer pays **20%** of the dues the rest of the **80%** would be waived off, this will benefit **80,000** middle income businessmen
